



## LEEZEN Alert Bulletin December 2012

There are many LEZs tightening or starting on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013. All dates below are 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 unless stated.


### Austria


[Styria / Steiermark Province](#) in Austria has a Lorry LEZ that operates in many towns in southern and eastern Styria, including [Graz](#). The standards are currently Euro 1, tightening to Euro 2 from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013.



[A12 Motorway](#) night time ban, exemptions are now Euro V, Euro VI and EEV lorries only.

### Germany

[Remscheid](#) starting Diesel Euro 3(PM), Petrol Euro 1 

The [Ruhr](#) area LEZ tightening to Diesel Euro 3(PM), Petrol Euro 1 . This covers the towns/cities of: [Bochum](#), [Bottrop](#), [Castrop-Rauxel](#), [Dortmund](#), [Duisburg](#), [Essen](#), [Gelsenkirchen](#), [Gladbeck](#), [Herne](#), [Herten](#), [Mühlheim](#), [Oberhausen](#), and [Recklinghausen](#).

Other LEZs in Nordrhein-Westfalen are also tightening to Diesel Euro 3(PM), Petrol Euro 1 , these are [Bonn](#), [Dortmund](#), [Hagen](#) and [Köln \(Cologne\)](#)

Baden-Württemberg LEZs tighten to Diesel Euro 4(PM), Petrol Euro 1 . This covers the towns/cities of [Freiberg am Neckar](#), [Freiburg](#), [Heidelberg](#), [Heilbronn](#), [Herrenberg](#), [Ilsfeld](#), [Karlsruhe](#), [Leonberg](#), [Ludwigsburg](#), [Mannheim](#), [Markgröningen](#), [Mühlacker](#), [Pfinztal](#), [Pforzheim](#), [Remscheid](#), [Reutlingen](#), [Schwäbisch-Gmünd](#), [Tübingen](#), [Ulm](#) and [Urbach](#). ([Stuttgart](#) is already ).

Elsewhere [Halle \(Saale\)](#) and [Magdeburg](#) tighten to Diesel Euro 4(PM), Petrol Euro 1 .

### Italy

[Rome's](#) ZTL1 for Coaches tightens to Euro 4.

In Umbria, [Perugia](#) and [Ponte San Giovanni](#) have emergency measure LEZs that can be implemented from 10<sup>th</sup> December – 31<sup>st</sup> March when they have high pollution levels.

### Czech Republic

[Prague's](#) LEZ tightens to Euro 4.
